After a few turbulent years as a teen mom, she attended college, gave her life to Christ and married her sweetheart, Josh.

In 2015, Jamie used her own experiences to help others as she began volunteering for Pregnancy Services of Delta County. In 2020, she was hired as the Client Services and

Volunteer Coordinator. In 2023, Jamie became the Executive Director of Pregnancy Services.

Jamie is a native of Escanaba and now lives in the Carney area. She and her husband Josh have four children—Ariah, Devin, Averyanna and Dallin, a granddaughter Alahnya, and many animals on their hobby farm. Jamie is driven by the Lord and she truly believes He has placed her exactly where He has called her to be.
