### CARE HELP HOPE

**Katie\* came to us several years ago** at our former center on Ludington Street. As a senior in high school, she was raised in a Christian home and she

lived with her parents. In a moment of weakness, she went further with her boyfriend than she intended and a few weeks later, **she found out she was pregnant.** She was in despair because she realized this changed her life plans. A friend told her that Pregnancy Services could help so she gave us a call.

Katie had always considered herself to be pro-life and knew she could never have an abortion. However, although she had experience babysitting her neighbor's kids **she felt inadequate when it came to raising a baby.** Also, **she knew her parents would be very disappointed** and she did not want to tell them she was pregnant. To make matters worse, her boyfriend recently broke up with her and **she felt very alone**.

As we talked with her, **we showed her LOVE** (Listening & Learning from her; Opening her Options; showing her a Vision and her Value; and Extending & Empowering her). We encouraged Katie to tell her parents and we gave her the words to say. **We also explained that we would walk hand in hand with her on her journey** through our *Earn While You Learn* parenting classes and mentorship. We told her that through her participation, she would be able to earn necessary things for her baby such as diapers, wipes, baby clothes, and baby furniture. **Katie felt empowered to face the difficulties** placed before her.

In the months that followed, **Katie's parents became her biggest supporters**. Katie graduated from high school, gave birth to a beautiful baby boy, Colin, and enrolled in classes at Bay College the following Fall. Throughout this time, she continued living with her parents and participated in our *Earn While You Learn* classes. **Katie eventually got a job as a receptionist and moved into her own apartment with her son.** 

Recently, one of our volunteers saw Katie in town. Colin is now in kindergarten and is learning to read. He loves playing with his friends, 4-wheeling with his Grandpa, and reading to his Grandma. Katie remembered all the help she received from Pregnancy Services those years ago and she is very grateful!

Each day at Pregnancy Services, we journey with clients just like Katie to help them choose life, as well as, help on their parenting journey. Soon, you will also have a chance to help us walk hand in hand with our clients. On Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, we will hold our 10<sup>th</sup> annual *Walk for Life*. 
## WELCOME ALESHA SWANSON
